Race/Ethnicity Reporting

Due to mandated data collection and reporting requirement changes from the United States Department of Education, the Ohio Department of Education is changing the reporting of race/ethnicity information. Per the US Department of Education requirements, when collecting race/ethnicity information the district must collect the information by using a two part question:

Part One:

My child is of Hispanic/Latino Heritage (a person of Cuban, Mexican, Puerto Rican, South or Central American or other Spanish culture or origin)? Yes or No (circle one)

Part Two:

Circle your child's Ethnic Code:

A-Asian (origins of the Far East, Southeast Asia or Indian subcontinent. The area includes Cambodia, China, India, Japan, Korea, Malaysia, Pakistan, the Philippine Islands, Thailand and Vietnam.

B – Black or African American (Non-Hispanic) Persons having origins in any of the black racial groups in Africa.

H – Hispanic/Latino – description listed above.

I – American Indian or Alaskan Native (Persons having origins in any of the original peoples of North and South America (including Central America) and who maintain tribal affiliation or community attachment.

P – Native Hawaiian or Other Pacific Islander (Persons having origins in any of the original peoples of Hawaii, Guam, Samoa or Pacific Islands.

W – White, Non-Hispanic (People who have origins in any of the original peoples of Europe, North Africa, or the Middle East.

M – Multiracial – Persons having origins in two or more of the above options.
