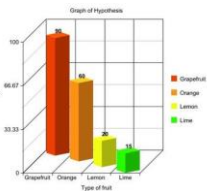
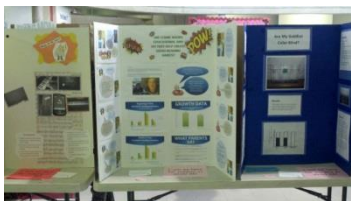


7th GRADE NEWSLETTER
