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Dear Chippewa Parents & Students,

As we approach an extended time of school closure and learning from home, we realize students will need access to a device for online instruction and assignments. Chippewa Schools has a limited supply of Chromebooks and in an effort to address student needs, we are allowing these devices to be signed out to families. (1 per family) If you have access to an electronic device that allows you to complete online work, please do not request a Chromebook. At this time only grades 3-12 will have school work assigned through Google or other online resources. Grades Pre-K-2 will have hard copy packets mailed or available by pick-up.

Students may sign out a Chromebook to keep at home until we return to a normal school schedule: Please review the following information that outlines Chromebook expectations. Chromebooks are property of Chippewa Local Schools and are assigned to individual students/families. Chromebooks are issued to students as an educational tool and should be used in that capacity. The cost for replacing and/or repairing the Chromebook due to damage, negligence, or theft that occurs while the Chromebook is assigned to the student shall be the sole responsibility of the undersigned parent/guardian. Failure to follow procedures and expectations could result in computer restrictions, disciplinary action, and/or financial responsibility.

Chippewa Local Schools Acceptable Use Policy should continue to be followed at home. The activities that are not permitted include, but are not limited to the following:

- Cyberbullying
- Sending or displaying offensive communication or pictures
- Using obscene language
- Harassing, insulting or attacking others
- Violating copyright laws including failure to cite online sources
- Giving personal information without permission from teacher and parent/guardian
- Disabling or circumventing filtering/security software
- Using logins, usernames, and/or passwords of other users
- Damaging or modifying computers, computer systems or computer needs
