

Scholarship Information for Graduating Seniors

The scholarship process can be overwhelming. Here are some specific links and tips to assist you in finding the money to attend college with the least debt. It is encouraged that students create a new 'disposable' email to use specifically for scholarship search sites. Students can set up profiles on multiple scholarship search sites, and these sites will send scholarships that students may qualify for to the email. Checking this email regularly and spending a specific time each week researching scholarship opportunities is important to gaining as much scholarship money as possible.

Senior students are given the links listed here and more individual scholarship opportunities sent to their email at the beginning of their senior year and then throughout the year as scholarships come to the school counselors. School counselors are available throughout the year to help students with their scholarship process.

The largest scholarship usually comes from the College or University the student chooses to attend. This is primarily called a Merit Scholarship and is awarded based on GPA, or ACT/SAT scores. Students can always contact their college's financial aid office and/or website to find out if they offer other opportunities.

FAFSA or Federal financial aid is available through <https://studentaid.gov/h/apply-for-aid/fafsa>. Colleges require this to be filled out for them to complete an 'Award letter' to break down the costs of college. The FAFSA gives opportunities for both Federal and State grants and loans.

Local Doylestown Scholarships will be available to Seniors to complete in February. Students can pick up their packet on February 1 and the completed applications are due, with copies made for each application they apply to, by February 29.
